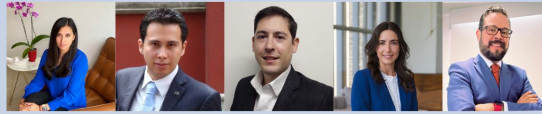


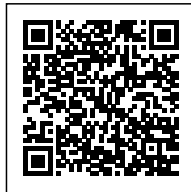
CHEVEZ RUIZ ZAMARRIPA PROMOTES 7 NEW PARTNERS
