Chilectra is Chile's largest electricity distribution company and a subsidiary of Enersis, which is part of Italian energy multinational Enel. As a result of this deal, Chilectra was divided into two companies: Chilectra Chile and Chilectra Américas. This operation marks a major reorganisation of the Latin American assets of Enel.

Carey advised Chilectra, with partners Alfonso Silva and Salvador Valdés leading the team. Enel instructed Cariola, Diez, Pérez-Cotapos & Cía with partners Francisco Javier Illanes and Juan Antonio Parodi taking lead roles on the transaction.
