We also emphasise the importance of women's work in the legal sector and, for the second year in a row, we present a ranking of the most gender-diverse Latin American firms, where women form an

In the Brazilian version, we also talked about the process of adaptation of companies and organisations to the General Data Protection Law (LGPD), which, this year, celebrates its fifth anniversary and continues to generate effective advances to the right to privacy.

Also in the Portuguese version, Tatiana Cappa Chiaradia, tax litigation partner at Cândido Martins Advogados, spoke about a recent decision of the Federal Supreme Court (STF).
