With the deal, the broadcasting now changes hands to media companies Turner and Fox, which jointly won the bidding for the rights. The joint contract is for five years with a renewable clause for five more. In exchange, the companies will pay the Asociación de Fútbol Argentina approximately \$1 billion.
