

MUÑIZ RAMIREZ INSTRUCTED ON BOND PLACEMENT BY ENGIE ENERGÍA PERU

Peruvian law firm Muñiz, Ramirez, Perez Taiman & Olaya advised Engie Energía Perú on the first issuance of its dual currency bond programme.

The bonds were acquired by local institutional investors, for a total of \$75 million (in US dollars and Peruvian soles). This first issuance is done under Engie's \$500 million dual currency corporate bond programme.

Engie Energía Perú (formerly EnerSur) is one of the largest electricity generation companies in Peru and a subsidiary of Engie (formerly GDF Suez), the French multinational.
