
PÉREZ BUSTAMANTE & PONCE INSTRUCTED ON MAJOR PORT CONCESSION BID

Pérez Bustamante & Ponce advised DP World on the winning bid for a deep water port concession in Ecuador.

The project, worth \$1.2 billion, is the first in which the recently enacted public and private partnership regime was applied. It includes dredging of the new channel in Posorja, near Guayaquil, and the construction of a 22 km road that will connect the city with the port. The port will allow post-Panamax ships to dock in Ecuador for the first time.

DP World is headquartered in Dubai and operates over 65 port terminals around the world
