Infun is a car parts manufacturer headquartered in Barcelona, with operations in Spain, Italy and China.

This operation is GIS's second acquisition in Europe, in 2015 the company bought ACE, a car parts manufacturer with operations in Spain, Czech Republic and Poland.

Santander provided financial advise to GIS while KPMG gave accounting support.

GIS also instructed Cuatrecasas in Spain, Gianni Origoni in Italy and Zhong Lung in China. The company retained CMS Hasche Sigle for antitrust advise in Germany.
