The issuance was made under its Global Program for the issuance of Notes for a maximum outstanding amount of up to U\$\$150,000,000 or its equivalent in other currencies, for a nominal amount of U\$\$10,295,290 at a fixed annual nominal rate of 9.5%, maturing on August 8, 2025, denominated in US dollars and payable in pesos.

The Additional Class 17 Notes are additional to the Original Class 17 Notes issued on 8 August 2022 for a nominal amount of US\$9,337,600 at a fixed annual nominal rate of 9.5%, maturing on 8 August 2025.

After the issuance of the Additional Class 17 Notes, the total outstanding par value of the Class 17 Notes is U\$S 19,632,890.

Banco de Servicios y Transacciones, Puente Hnos, Facimex Valores, Portfolio Investment and Zofingen Securities acted as underwriters; Banco de Servicios y Transacciones and Puente Hnos acted as arrangers, and Banco de Servicios y Transacciones acted as settlement agent.
